## Toddler DK Rolled Edge Hat Pattern Designed by Christina Knight

Hats are easy to work in the round. This hat is great for a last minute gift or a quick and satisfying project for you! Enjoy building your skills with circular and double-pointed needles! For those of you who know the magic loop method, you can do these hats and any hats using one 40" circular needle!

**Materials:** Approx. 145 yds of a DK weight yarn.  
Size #4 16" circular *and* dpn needles or size to achieve gauge  
Tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 5.5 stitches to 1 inch

**Size:** Average toddler head circumference is 16 inches

**Stitches used:** k = knit, k2tog = knit two stitches together

### Instructions:

Cast on 90 stitches

Join in the round and place marker to indicate the beginning of each round.

Knit even for 5-6 inches.

Switch to double pointed needles by evenly distributing 90 stitches onto 3 needles. Slip 30 stitches on each needle. Use the fourth needle as you continue working in the round.

### Begin crown shaping with decrease stitches:

Round 1: k13, k2tog, k13, k2tog – repeat for entire round

Round 2: k12, k2tog, k12, k2tog – repeat

Round 3: k11, k2tog, k11, k2tog – repeat

Round 4: k10, k2tog, k10, k2tog – repeat

Round 5: k9, k2tog, k9, k2tog – repeat

Round 6: k8, k2tog, k8, k2tog – repeat

Round 7: k7, k2tog, k7, k2tog – repeat

Round 8: k6, k2tog, k6, k2tog – repeat

Round 9: k5, k2tog, k5, k2tog – repeat

Round 10: k4, k2tog, k4, k2tog – repeat

Round 11: k3, k2tog, k3, k2tog – repeat

Round 12: k2, k2tog, k2, k2tog – repeat

Round 13: k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog – repeat

Round 14: k2tog for entire round

Take tapestry needle and weave in through remaining stitches and pull together to finish hat. Weave in tails.
