

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## August 16-22 - Experience Uganda with The Max Foundation

### Itinerary

**August 16/17 (Thurs/Fri) - Depart USA for Entebbe, Uganda** - Please note: Flight options from the USA can take 2-3 days with the time change.

**August 18 (Sat) - Arrive Entebbe Evening** - Private airport transfer from Entebbe International airport to Entebbe hotel. Dinner included for those who arrive earlier. Overnight Entebbe.

**August 19 (Sun) - Symposium** - Join African and American patients, doctors, and advocates for a **Symposium with The Max Foundation**. In the evening, we'll have an **outdoor torchlit dinner**, sharing our connection with The Max Foundation, prepare for "The Last Mile", and celebrate. Overnight Entebbe.

**August 20 (Mon) - "The Last Mile"** - After breakfast we'll depart with patient leaders from The Max Foundation's work throughout Africa for an inspiring **symbolic one-mile walk along the mouth of the Nile River**. We'll then have lunch on-board a **boat on the Nile River** and find some souvenirs in Jinja before heading back to Entebbe. In the evening, we'll have a **celebratory dinner with local food, music, and more**. Overnight Entebbe.


**August 21 (Tues) - Uganda Cancer Institute Tour** - We'll spend the day **touring the Uganda Cancer Institute**, learning more about The Max Foundation's work in Uganda and vision for the future. After a **final farewell dinner**, we'll return to the hotel in Entebbe. Overnight Entebbe.

**August 22 (Wed)** - Depart for USA or Optional Gorilla Trekking Extension, Arrive USA

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**Price** - \$2,295 per passenger based on double occupancy (single supplement \$700)

**Includes** - Local English Speaking Tour Manager, Airport Transfer on Arrival, Ground Transportation, Mineral Water Throughout, Full Board (three meals per day, Uganda Visa Fees and Personalized Application Handling, Taxes and Service Fees



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## Optional Extension - Gorilla or Chimp Trekking in Bwindi Impenetrable Forest

### Itinerary

**August 22 (Wed)** - Today we'll take a **morning flight from Entebbe to Kihiki** and transfer to the Bwindi Lodge. Depending on flight schedules, we should arrive in the late afternoon with time for a **relaxing dinner before retiring in our forest lodge**, with dramatic intense views of the forest canopy across a serene stream.

**August 23 (Thurs)** - After an early morning breakfast, we'll drive to the entrance of **Bwindi Impenetrable Forest** for a quick training and registration. Then we'll begin our trek into the forest with our guides to find the gorillas, which can take from half an hour to three quarters of the day. The steeply forested landscape is incredibly dense but crisscrossed by numerous animal trails. Once we find the gorillas, we can **spend up to an hour observing the gorilla's behavior in the wild** from a distance before heading back to the lodge. Overnight Bwindi Lodge.

**August 24 (Fri)** - Today we'll depart the Bwindi Lodge for our **flight from Kihiki airport back to Entebbe**. Depending on flight times, you may depart in the evening August 23 or overnight in the included Entebbe hotel and depart the morning of August 24.


**August 25 (Sat)** - Depart for USA, Arrive USA

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**Price** - \$2,500 USD per passenger based on double occupancy (\$340 additional single supplement)

**Includes** - English Speaking Tour Guides Throughout, 4x4 Land Cruisers Throughout, Mineral Water Throughout, Full Board (three meals per day), In-Country Airfare, Taxes and Service Fees, Bwindi Gorilla Tourist Permits

**Does NOT Include** - International Airfare (est \$1,000-\$2,000 per person), Tips (est \$100 per person), Souvenirs, Soft Drinks or Alcohol at meals



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
